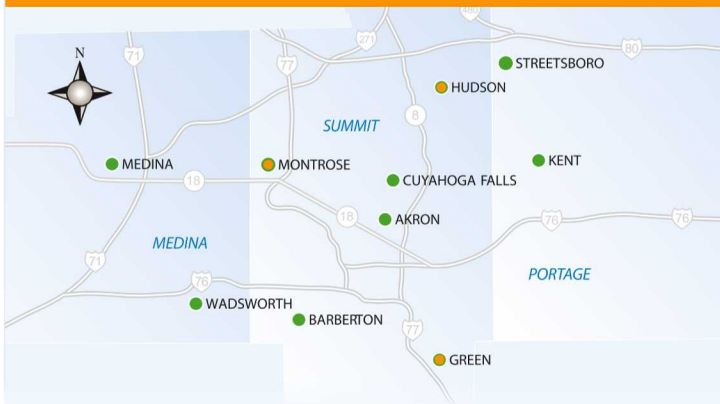

What is a Physician Assistant?

A Physician Assistant (PA) is a nationally certified and state-licensed medical professional. The PA is part of a team that includes physicians and other clinicians who work to make sure your healthcare is of the highest quality.

PAs can provide all types of medical care and can be found in all medical specialties. PAs are trained to diagnose, treat, and prescribe and have shown they provide high quality, cost-effective care since the profession was introduced almost 50 years ago. Just as physicians, PAs are required to pass national certification testing every 10 years. PAs may practice in any setting, such as an office, clinic, or hospital.

PAs practice and prescribe medication in all 50 states, the District of Columbia and all U.S. territories, with the exception of Puerto Rico.
